Monthly management fees are just £144 per month. (This is equivalent to just one small class a month) or 10% of monthly earnings, whichever is greater.

This fee includes continual personal development training, DFA support membership, website and email management and central advertising and head office support.

Although our trainers run their own Daisy businesses, we are very much a team and group of friends who support each other. Our forum is open to all questions whether it be about business, marketing, first aid or anything else.

We even have an #askdaisy group where Daisies can discuss life stuff and ask for advice in confidence.

Additional costs will be public liability and indemnity insurance which can be obtained easily online. The cost will vary depending on the insurance company and area of the country but usually around \pounds 12-18 per month combined.

Earning potential

As a Daisy First Aid Franchisee you will be able to choose when to work and arrange your bookings around your family life... and earn a minimum of £90 per hour!

Grow a successful Daisy business...

The recommended price for a 2 hour parent class is ± 30 per person with a minimum of 6 people attending a class. Home classes mean no venue fees for you although you have the option to use local venues too if you wish.

Classes are between 4 people and a maximum of 20 attending so a 2 hour class will earn you between £180 and £600. Running 4 classes per week could bring in earnings of between £720 and £2400.

Level 3 qualifications for childcare professionals have a recommended price of £100 per person. You can train a class of up to 12 candidates at a time with an earning potential of £1200. DofE compliant one hour classes for school students have a recommended price of £100 per class. Both primary and secondary schools are required to have every child trained in basic first aid.

Our proven marketing training lessons will give you all the knowledge and tools to help you grow a successful Daisy business.

Our very popular Daisy First Aid Kits, Books and Magnets are available for your customers to purchase increasing your earning potential even further.
